

Community Based Job Training Grant (CBJTG) Scholarships

Funding is available for existing students and area residents wishing to enroll in a course offered through Morrisville State College's Renewable Energy Training Center. Individuals may receive financial aid from other sources and still be eligible to apply for CBJTG scholarships. Duplicate financial aid may not be received. Scholarship funding will be used to pay for a class one time. If a class is repeated, scholarship funding may not be applied for tuition to the same class.

Renewable Energy Training Center funding is designed to be used only after all other available sources of funding (Pell, TAP, WIA, Workforce Development Programs) have been accessed and are not able to defray the costs of the class. Scholarships may be offered for all or part of the cost of course depending upon the cost of the course and the circumstances of the participant.

Funds will only be provided with the completion of a Community Based Job Training Grant Student Scholarship Application and Outcome Tracking Application. Permission for the release of information is included on these forms and acknowledged with the applicant's signature. Paperwork must be completed prior to taking a class for which scholarship funds are requested.

To be eligible:

1. Participants must be accepted for admission to MSC/MVCC for credit programs; admission to MSC/MVCC is **not** necessary for non-credit programs (e.g., the Fundamentals of Solar Thermal Systems).
2. Participants must be a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States, with a Social Security number, in order to receive Federal funds.
3. Participants must submit this Scholarship Application form and Outcome Tracking Application form.

Scholarship funds will be used to cover the cost of training and training materials.
