Environmental Education

- 1) Learn more about a non-profit organization fundraising, organizing events, and running educational workshops
 - a) Organize and plan Family Fun Programs and Volunteer work,
 - b) Observe educational workshops (watch Sarah conduct the workshop)
 - i) Lead educational workshops (lectures when visiting schools/Programs at the center)
- 2) To become more of a leader
 - a) Improve teamwork skills (with other employees, the public...)
 - b) Scheduling programs/workshops from start to finish (contacting and scheduling up to running the program)
- 3) To plan for trail signage around the center trails, the Farm Tower trail and Pine Ridge trail. Depending on the time frame, possibly moving forward with the trail signs plan and starting to make them or design them.
 - a) Determine where signs are needed
 - b) Determine which signs need improvement (wording, placement, where they are hung)
 - c) Mark on map where signs are needed/will go
 - i) Make signs
 - ii) Put signs on trail
