## 1. Megacities

- a. The emerging **MEGACITIES** of the world
- Megacity: A vast urban area containing a number of cities and their surrounding suburbs: "super cities" with more than 10 million people. Most are found in low-income nations.

In 1975 there were only 5 megacities worldwide. In 2003, there were 20 megacities. By 2014, the number of megacities had grown to over 30. 2018: Megacities = 31 By 2030, the number of megacities will grow to over 40.

In 1950 only 30% of the world pop. (2.5 billion) were urban: by 2025 over 60% of the world population will be urban (over 5 billion).
